The purpose of the Construction Safety Excellence Awards is to recognize those construction companies who excel at safety performance. CSEA closely examines each candidate's commitment to safety and occupational health management and risk control. Judges look for evidence of company management commitment, active employee participation, safety training, work site hazard identification and control, and safety program innovation. The award is presented by Associated General Contractors.

There are six divisions for award nominations; Building Division, Construction Management, Municipal Division, Heavy Division, Specialty and Highway with several sub-divisions based on work hours. Rock City was nominated in the Building Division category under the 100,000 or less work hours sub-division. Rock City was the exclusive award recipient for this sub-division in the state as only one award is presented for each sub-division.
