7. COLLUSIVE AGREEMENTS

- A. Each person submitting a bid for any portion of the work contemplated by the bidding documents shall execute the affidavit, in the form provided by MDHA, to the effect that he has not colluded with any other person, firm or corporation in regard to any bid submitted. Such affidavit shall be attached to the bid.
- B. The successful Bidder shall submit for each proposed subcontractor an affidavit in the form provided in Sections 103 & 104, SUBCONTRACTS under GENERAL CONDITIONS, PART I.

8. STATEMENT OF BIDDER'S QUALIFICATIONS

Each bid must be accompanied by a statement on the form furnished for that purpose, a copy of which is included in the Contract Documents, a statement of the Bidder's qualifications, his experience record in constructing the type of improvements embraced in the Contract Documents, and his organization and equipment available for the work contemplated; and, when specifically requested by the Metropolitan Development and Housing Agency, a detailed financial statement. The Agency shall have the right to take such steps as it deems necessary to determine the ability of the Bidder to perform his obligations under the Contract and the Bidder shall furnish the Agency all such information and data for this purpose as it may request. The right is reserved to reject any bid where an investigation of the available evidence or information does not satisfy the Agency that the Bidder is qualified to carry out properly the terms of the Contract.

The below subcontractors must be qualified for the work for which they are to be subcontracted to the General Contractor. To be determined qualified, the below subcontractors must meet the Qualifications listed in the Technical Specifications and demonstrate past success on projects of comparable scope, complexity, and value. Evaluation of the subcontractors' qualifications will be utilized in determination of the Bidder's ability to successfully perform the obligations of the Contract. The Agency shall have the right to take such steps as it deems necessary to determine the Subcontractors' qualifications for this purpose. The Agency reserves the right to reject any bids for which the proposed subcontractors do not meet the required qualifications.
